It was great seeing you again this week. As promised, here are the next steps for our work.

We have started with your end goal in mind – to identify who is being served, by which programs, and to what outcomes. When we met with Chris and team 11/16/2018 we scoped out an initial proof of concept to connect a few initial disparate systems together, prove the approach, then scale more broadly to other data sets. Chris and team identified 3 data sets and we worked on the **attached** scope document.

The next step for the POC is to schedule a working-session to actually execute the plan. The County will leverage their existing AWS account, and our Solution Architect Alistair McLean will guide the County through the process to connect data from the 3 systems together (HMIS, Cerner, and Visual Homes). Knowing that client matching and deduplication are such a painpoint, we would like to include our Partner Novetta in the meeting to demonstrate how their solution addresses this challenge.

## The 3 open questions are:

- Is your team available for a half day workingsession January 8, 9<sup>h</sup>?
- What are the data dictionaries for each of the data sets in scope for the POC, (HMIS, Cerner, and Visual Homes)? (fields names, field formats, etc.)
- Are there any changes to the scope of the POC that we want to make before we initiate?
