Thanks to all for participating in the call today. I have created a folder where we can begin to assemble the data required for the Northern Virginia Region Node Certification. You should shortly receive a notification that the **CCI Northern Virginia Region Node Folder** has been shared with you.

Specifically, there are Google Sheet Tables (similar to Excel) that need to be completed by each stakeholder partner. These tables are as follows:

Academic Institution Research by Faculty Table (for GWU, Mason, NOVA, Marymount any other higher ed institution that wishes to join the NoVa Node)

Enrollment Tech Talent Pipeline Academic Institutions Table (for GWU, Mason, NOVA, Marymount any other higher ed institution that wishes to join the NoVa Node)

Businesses Table (Any non-academic institution, non-government partner, for profit organization. Note R&D efforts may be listed there as appropriate to business)

Federal Partners Table (All Federal Partners)

Other Regional Node Partners Table (Non-profit entities, P-12 Schools, convenors, economic development organizations, accelerators, training organizations, incubators, consortium)

Since these are Google Sheets (similar to Excel), information may be added and auto saved to the templates as a living document and multiple participants may add data. In some cases, if you have a great deal of information to contribute to a table, you may wish to simply download the Google Sheet, add your information (you can open in Excel if you prefer), and then upload your completed table back to the folder. Do please add your institution's name to the file title if you go this route. We will work with whatever form in which you wish to deliver the information back to this folder. Every CCI Node Partner must enter their information to the appropriate table(s). We have agreed to a deadline of **March 21** to deliver the data to the folder.

Steve Partridge has agreed to reach out to other Community Colleges as appropriate. NVTC has agreed to reach out to its membership and NVRC has agreed to reach out to other partners who have been engaged in the Cyber training and Education Roadmap effort. Please all do share information about this initiative with any partners that you think need to be involved. New partners will need to share their POC with me, and add their information to the appropriate table. I and Deb Crawford would be happy to speak to any potential partner if its helpful, please let us know.

I will organize a follow up call on **March 25** to discuss the narrative that will go along with the data we collect. The narrative will be somewhat dependent on the ecosystem of partnerships that we are quickly developing.

Thanks again to all of you who were able to participate in our CCI Northern Virginia Node planning meeting and welcome to those of you who have expressed interest in being involved in the Node strategic planning effort. If you need background on the Commonwealth Cyber Initiative, please see the attached document entitled *CCI Blueprint final*.

We have received the Instructions for Application for Certification of the Regional Node (see attached *agenda-iten-4c-cci*). As we anticipated, a good deal of data will need to be assembled to meet the requirements for Certification. We expect more details to be clarified at the upcoming VRIC meeting scheduled for March 12 (<http://www.schev.edu/index/institutional/grants/va-research-investment-fund/vric-meetings>).

We would like to schedule a call with you on **Friday March 15 at 9:30 - 10:45 AM** to discuss some of the specific definitions of the data required for Certification and to discuss how to move forward with the certification process and parallel strategic planning for the Node.
