We live in the Westover neighborhood of Arlington, VA at 5712 1th Rd N. Arlington County as been doing what we believe to be some sort of housing improvement project in our neighborhood, and we have been told by those working for you that it is approximately 6 buildings worth of public housing. Please see the attached photos of the unacceptable damage done to our property as well as the construction trailer, trash bin and construction equipment storage trailer that is now parked against our property line outside of our home. This is absolutely unacceptable and we expect the county to remedy this issue immediately. Along with the eye sore and damage to our property, as Arlington residents and tax payers, your crews keep the very loud generator running on the weekends at times and work beyond the allowed hours per the county- 7am to 7pm. Please advise immediately as we are looking for the County to remedy an unacceptable set of circumstances. Should the county be uninterested in fixing this eye sore and damage causing project to our property, we will go ahead and being legal proceedings as necessary to ensure the damage is fixed and the trailers and trash bin are re-located as to not disrupt our lifestyle.
